## **Aberdeen High School Discipline Procedures**

## **Cell Phone Rule Interpretation 2018/19**

Time of Day	Acceptable Use of Cellular Device for Students at Aberdeen High School	Unacceptable Use of Cellular Device for Students at Aberdeen High School. Student will be sent to the Main Office for device confiscation.
Arrival to school until 7:25 am (start of homeroom)	Students may use personal device upon arrival to school and until homeroom begins. Headphones/earbuds may be worn in the morning before homeroom begins but needs to be put away prior to being in homeroom at 7:25 am.	In the morning prior to homeroom, students may not play music from their device without headphones/earbuds, take pictures or videos, use the device to bully or harass another student, or infringe upon the rights of others.
7:25 am-7:35 am (Homeroom)	Students may not use or operate their cellular device during homeroom. Any use is considered a violation. It should be put away or if placed upon desk, it should be faced toward desk.	Any use of the device during homeroom is a violation.
Class changes during the school day	Students may use their personal device in the hallway during class changes. If a student leaves the classroom during class, a personal device may not be used in the hallway or restroom while class is in session.	During the class change, students may not play music or have headphones/earbuds in their ears. Students may not take pictures or videos during any class change. Devices may not be used to bully or harass another student nor infringe upon the rights of others. Phone calls should not be made or received during class changes.
During class	Students are permitted to possess a personal device in class.  The personal device should be silenced and secured away or face down on the desk unless permission is granted by the teacher for specific use. Use of BYOT will be under the strict guidelines of the teacher in the room.	During class, the teacher will provide specific directions that will govern acceptable use for that class period. Devices may not be used to bully or harass another student nor infringe upon the rights of others. Phone calls should not be made or received during class. Personal devices should be silent during class to ensure that student learning is not interrupted.
Cafeteria (Lunch)	Students may use their personal device in the cafeteria during lunch.	During lunch, students may not play music or have headphones/earbuds in their ears. Students may not take pictures or videos during lunch. Devices may not be used to bully or harass another student nor infringe upon the rights of others. Phone calls should not be made or received.
After school and at evening events	Students may use their personal device after school and at evening events.	Devices may not be used to bully or harass another student nor infringe upon the rights of others.
